



Session Information

Each session lasts one week, Monday through Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Camp sessions are divided into age groups (4-5, 6-7, 8-9, 10-12). Before-camp and after-camp care are available at an additional cost. Before-camp runs from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. at \$25/week. After-camp runs from 3:00 pm to 5:15 pm at \$50/week. (Days can be prorated at \$5/day or \$10/day). Campers must arrange before-camp and after-camp care prior to the week needed. An additional \$1 per minute will be charged for pick-up after 5:20 p.m.

Week 1 (June 5 - June 9) *Our Galaxy & Beyond*
 3, 2, 1, blast off! Become a junior astronaut as we set out to answer questions about our solar system. Learn about lunar phases, space exploration, and the life cycle of stars during our out-of-this-world astronomy week.

Week 2 (June 12 - June 16) *Wild About Nature*
