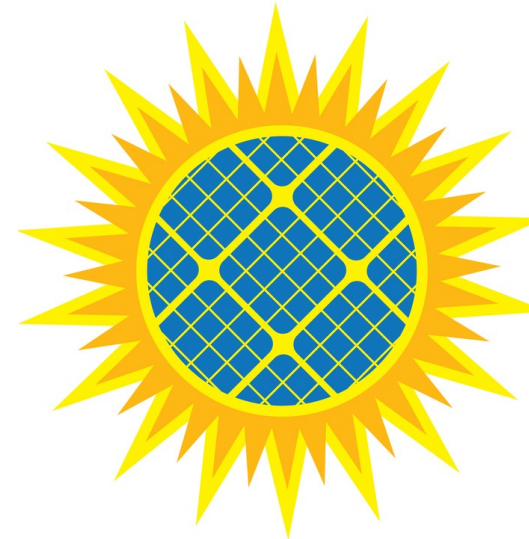


## Session Information

Each session lasts one week, Monday through Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Camp sessions are divided into age groups (4-5, 6-7, 8-9, 10-12). Before-camp and after-camp care are available at an additional cost. Before-camp runs from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. at \$25/week. After-camp runs from 3:00 pm to 5:15 pm at \$50/week. (Days can be prorated at \$5/day or \$10/day). Campers must arrange before-camp and after-camp care prior to the week needed. An additional \$1 per minute will be charged for pick-up after 5:20 p.m.

**Week 5 (July 8 - July 12) *Ocean Adventures***

Dive in for a fun-filled week of watery fun. We'll explore the depths of the oceans as well as the waterways in our own backyards. Join us as we learn about how water played a role in early trade to the importance of conserving this precious resource.

**Week 6 (July 15- July 19) *Mummy Mysteries***

Ever wonder where mummies are found? Or how they were created? Explore mummy discoveries from around the world and learn about the history of other cultures through the clues mummies left behind.

**Week 7 (July 22 - July 26) *Crazy Critters***

Why do earthworms need to stay moist? Do frogs always lay their eggs in water? There is so much to explore when we study crazy critters!
