

WHERE: All Spring Mini Camp sessions take place at the Brazos Valley Museum of Natural History.

WHO: The programs are designed for children ages 4-12.

WHEN: Camp will run from 9 A.M. to 3 P.M. Before and After Camp Care is available for an additional fee of \$5.00 per hour. All campers must arrange Before and After Camp Care prior to the day needed. *Late fees may be assessed for late pick-up.*

MEALS: Lunch *must* be provided for all children. Please include 2 snacks and a water bottle.

REGISTRATION: Pre-registration is required for your children to attend, and one-half of the total registration fee is needed to hold your child's space. Museum programs fill quickly, so please register early. To register your child or children for this program, please submit one form per child:

REFUND POLICY: *Refunds are not available unless a replacement camper is located to fill the vacancy.

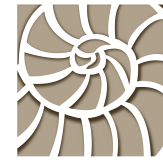

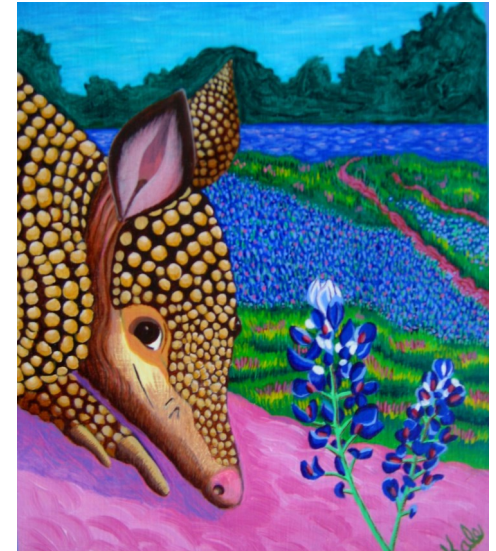
